Spoiler Showerhead

This showerhead will save you up to 75 liters of water during a 10-minute shower. Easy and convenient, it is self-cleaning and maintenance free.



Spray Swivel Aerator

Aerators are small screens that screw to taps and add air to water flow, so you can get adequate spray using less water. It uses less than 6 liters of water per minute and provides the option of jet and wide spray. The swivel action allows for effective cleaning.



Faucet Aerator

Constructed with long-lasting flow-control plastic, this Faucet Aerator helps you save water by using less than 4 litres of water per minute.



Leak Detection Dye Tablets

A leaking toilet can waste up to 150 litres of water a day. Using Dye tablets can help prevent this as they can be used to test for water leaking from your toilet tank to your toilet bowl.



Teflon Tape

This Teflon Tape prevents water from leaking at hose connections.



Water Conservation Tips in the Home

- Install low-flow shower heads and toilets.
- Choose water-efficient fixtures and appliances for your kitchen and laundry.
- Don't let water run unnecessarily.
- Fix any leaks you may have! Ensure taps don't drip and toilets don't leak.
- Take shorter showers to use less water.
- Run appliances like dishwashers and washing machines only when they are full.
- Wash produce in the sink or a pan instead of with running water.
- Compost instead of using your garbage disposal.
- Turn off faucets tightly after use.
