


INSTITUTIONAL WATER RESTRICTIONS












This chart explains institutional water use in Abbotsford and Mission in stages 1 - 4 of water restrictions. Water restrictions are in place to ensure there is enough water for everyone in both communities as the temperature increases in the summer months.

WATER USE	STAGES				RESTRICTION DETAILS

 Watering lawns and grass boulevards					Stage 1: One morning per week. Even addresses on Mondays, Odd addresses on Tuesdays. Automatic watering from 4 - 6 am. Manual watering from 6 - 9 am.
 Watering new lawns or lawns being treated for the European Chafer Beetle					Stage 1: On any day within permitted times if in compliance with a sprinkling permit. Stage 2: Sprinkling permits issued in Stage 1 will remain in effect until permit expires. No new permits will be issued or renewed.
 Watering trees, shrubs, and flowers excluding edible plants <small>(Edible plants include vegetable gardens, fruit bearing plants and herbs. Edible plants are exempt from restrictions in Stages 1 to 3.)</small>					Stages 1 & 2: On any day from 4 - 9 am if using a sprinkler or soaker hose and on any day at any time if using a hand-held hose with automatic shut-off device, water container, or drip/micro spray irrigation. Stage 3: On any day at any time if using a hand-held hose with automatic shut-off device, water container, or drip/micro spray irrigation. Prohibited if using a sprinkler or soaker hose.
 Watering soil-based playing fields					Stage 1 & 2: Soil-based fields may be watered on alternate days between 11 pm - 8 am. Stage 3: Soil-based fields may be watered twice a week between 11 pm - 8 am. Watering newly over-seeded fields if in compliance with approved water management plan is allowed.
 Watering sand-based playing fields					Stage 1 & 2: Sand-based fields may be watered daily between 11 pm - 8 am. Stage 3: Sand-based fields may be watered on alternate days between 11 pm - 8 am. Watering newly over-seeded fields if in compliance with approved water management plan is allowed.
 Flushing water mains					Stage 1 & 2: Permitted for health and safety
 Hydrant use permits					
 Operating water play parks & pools					Stage 2 & 3: Prohibited except water play parks with user-activated switches.
 Topping up or filling aesthetic water features					
 Topping up or filling pools & hot tubs					Stage 3: Prohibited except for pools and hot tubs with a permit to operate in accordance with health authorities having jurisdiction over pool and hot tub regulation.
 Washing vehicles and boats					Stage 3: Prohibited except to clean windows, lights, mirrors, license plates, and boat engines for safety and invasive species management. Stage 4: Prohibited except to clean windows, lights, mirrors, license plates, and boat engines for safety
